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RESEARCH POLICY

The college has a well-defined policy for research promotion, which is available on the website.

Research is facilitated at the department level at Sri Meenakshi Government Arts College for Women (Autonomous) through curriculum-based undergraduate research projects, Post Graduate projects, M.Phil projects, Ph.D., projects and internship initiatives. Our institution's research committee, which was established in 2017, encourages faculty and student research. The Research Committee is responsible for a variety of research problems, including ethical concerns. The committee is made up of a five-member Core Group and an extended group that includes the heads of every Research Center. The Committee evaluates research ideas for feasibility, originality, and proper implementation. The college also encourages faculty members' involvement in national and international seminars, conferences, and workshops. It also aids in the organisation of departmental seminars and other research-related activities. Staff and students of our college are encouraged to present their research at national and international conferences and publish their papers. It has also been suggested that a Project Monitoring Committee was formed to facilitate the following research issues: advancing funds for sanctioned projects, providing seed money, simplifying procedures related to sanctions / purchases to be made by investigators, giving autonomy to the principal investigator/coordinator for utilising overhead charges, timely grant release, timely auditing, and submission of utilisation certificate to the funding authorities. All the processes listed above are in place to ensure that research plans and projects function smoothly. In addition to the foregoing functions, the Institute makes every effort to ensure that the teachers and students engaging in research are interactive with each other and collaboratively contribute to the welfare of the institution through meaningful research initiatives. ICT assistance promoting multi-media access, INFLIBNET are provided to all the departments in order to carry out research work. The centralised amenities include a library with a large selection of physical and electronic journal subscriptions, as well as internet access.
