The Board Scrutinized the existing B.Sc Geography Program Syllabus (2021-2022) for the academic year 2022-2023, Based on the Integrated state board of studies (TNSCHE) the syllabus restructured, updated and new courses are added.

The following resolutions are made by the scrutinizing Board Members.

### **Semester I**

- ❖ The existing syllabus of I semester and II semester Geomorphology core courses – G11 & G21 combined in this semester as CC1 -GEOMORPHOLOGY.
- ❖ According to TNSCHE instruction in the odd semester practical course introduced, for that the existing syllabus of PG1 spilited up and one part is reframed as REPRESENTATION OF MAP SCALE AND RELIEF with 3 hrs and 3 credit.

### **Semester - II**

- ❖ Another one part of existing practical course PG1 restructured, updated and named as CLIMATIC DATA AND WEATHER MAP INTERPRETATION with 3 hours and 3 credit.
- ❖ The existing syllabus core course III CLIMATOLOGY shifted from Third semester to this semester with 5 credits.



### Semester – III

- ❖ In the existing syllabus G51 oceanography transferred from Fifth semester to this semester with 4 credits.
- ❖ From the existing practical course PG4 projection units are carried out and restructured into separate practical course as MAP PROJECTION.
- ❖ NMEC – I has transferred from Fifth semester to this semester and same titled as FUNDAMENTALS OF PHYSICAL GEOGRAPHY with 2 credits. The syllabus is restructured.

### Semester – IV

- ❖ The existing syllabus cartography shifted from first semester to this semester with 4 credits.
- ❖ The existing practical course syllabus PG4 the surveying units are reallocated and changed as separate course to this semester titled as SURVEYING.
- ❖ The Non Major elective (NMG2) shifted from Sixth semester to this semester with same title as SOCIAL AND CULTURAL GEOGRAPHY.
- ❖ In Skill Enhancement course – I as POPULATION DATA ANALYSIS newly introduced with 2 credits.
- ❖ Newly self-allied course introduced as STATISTICAL DIAGRAMES AND MAPS for Fourth and Fifth semester with one hour each semester with 2 credits in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester.

### Semester – V

- ❖ The existing elective paper WORLD REGIONAL GEOGRAPHY has reallocated as core course with 5 credits.
- ❖ From the existing syllabus core course HUMAN GEOGRAPHY shifted from Fourth semester to this semester with 5 credits.
- ❖ The core course GEOGRAPHY OF INDIA transferred from Sixth semester to this semester with 5 credits.
- ❖ The existing practical course PG2 and PG3 restructured, updated and renamed as THEMATIC DATA ANALYSIS AND MAP INTERPRETATION.
- ❖ The existing core course GEOGRAPHY OF RESOURCE introduced as Discipline specific Elective course shifted from Third semester to this semester.
- ❖ For another Discipline specific Elective course – I for choice a new course AGRICULTURAL GEOGRAPHY introduced with 5 credits.
- ❖ Two new skilled Enhancement papers introduced in this one theory course as PRINCIPLES OF GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (GIS) & GLOBAL NAVIGATION SATILLITE SYSTEM (GNSS) and another one is practical course as FIELD SURVEY AND MAPPING ANALYSIS.



### Semester – VI

- ❖ The existing elective paper III Settlement Geography renamed as GEOGRAPHY OF SETTLEMENTS and shifted from 5<sup>th</sup> semester to 6<sup>th</sup> semester as a core course according to state integrated board guidelines.
- ❖ Basic Remote Sensing and Geographical Information System (G61) is restructured and updated as PRINCIPLES OF REMOTE SENSING with 5 Credits.
- ❖ The existing PG3 practical the REMOTE SENSING units only carried out and updated from 5<sup>th</sup> semester to 6<sup>th</sup> semester as Core Course practical as AERIAL PHOTOS AND SATELLITE IMAGE INTREPRETATION.
- ❖ In This semester Discipline Specific Elective Course III as GEOGRAPHY OF TAMIL NADU (EG63) as it is followed the existing syllabus and recoded. And another elective choice course BIOGEOGRAPHY has newly introduced
- ❖ And Discipline specific elective course III GEOGRAPHY OF ASIA shifted from core course to elective course into this semester and restructured
- ❖ And Existing skilled course TOUR AND TRAVEL shifted from Third semester to Sixth semester, its restructured, renamed and updated as GEOGRAPHY OF TRAVEL AND TOURISM which is another choice of discipline specific elective course
- ❖ According to TNSCHE guidelines Generic Elective Course newly introduced, for that the existing syllabus, SG32- DISASTER MANAGEMENT and SG66- GEOGRAPHY OF HEALTH are introduced and restructured.
