Annual Report of activities of Sri Meenakshi Government Arts College for Women(A) for the year 2023–2024.

The college began its journey in the year 1965, with 320 students, 13 teaching staff, and 13 non-teaching staff, the institution began its operations in a modest way. By 2023–2024, the institution has grown significantly, accommodating 4,826 students, 154 teaching staff, 1 librarian, 1 physical education director, 22 administrative support staff, and several departments. It offers a variety of programs, including 15 undergraduate courses, 15 postgraduate programs, 4 research centres. The institution, recognized for its excellence in higher education, continues its legacy through well-structured academic and extracurricular initiatives. It operates under the principles of inclusivity and quality education, contributing significantly to the educational landscape of Tamil Nadu. With its strong foundation in Tamil Nadu's higher education system, the institution stands as a prestigious hub for learning and research, operating with modern facilities to continue its commitment to academic excellence.

The college has achieved significant milestones in its journey. From July 2, 2018, the administration transitioned into the capable hands of the current management. Since then, the college has been effectively managed by the Principal, heads of various departments, and dedicated administrative and non-teaching staff.

The college, got autonomous status in 1998 as an affiliated institution of Madurai Kamaraj University, achieved significant recognition early on. During its 4th cycle of NAAC accreditation in April 2023, it was awarded a "B++" grade.

The success of the students has always been a key focus, and the leadership team has played a crucial role in maintaining the academic and administrative standards of the institution. The college council plays a significant role. In this academic year the college council functioned with the Principal, Dr. S. Vanathi as president and Head of Tamil department Dr. S. Chandra as vice-president. The students of the college excel in co-curricular activities, and under the leadership of the Physical Director, they actively participate in intercollegiate competitions, bringing recognition and laurels to the institution.

The faculty members and administrative staff work together with great dedication and discipline. Their collective efforts have established the college as a well-reputed institution, upholding high standards in both academics and overall development. Miss C. Ramya of III B.Sc. (Zoology) was selected as student representative of the council as it is functioning in an effective manner. Key Activities and Achievements:

1. International Yoga Day (21.06.23):

NSS units collaborated with the Natural State Yoga Foundation to celebrate International Yoga Day. Yoga expert Mr. Senthilkumar and his team demonstrated various yoga postures for the students.

2. Drug Abuse Awareness Rally (26.06.23):

In collaboration with the Anti-Drug Forum, an awareness rally was organized to mark International Day Against Drug Abuse. Police officer Mr. Ranjith and other officials led the rally from the college to the Thevar Statue. Students distributed pamphlets and conducted talks to raise awareness about the dangers of drug abuse.

Central Library of the College

The college operates a Central Library along with 15 departmental libraries, serving the academic needs of students and faculty. Key highlights include:

- A collection of 75,203 books, 200 project reports, 25 periodicals, 200 CDs, and 5 newspapers.
- All books are classified and indexed systematically under the Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) system for ease of access.
- Faculty and students can borrow books efficiently using library software integrated with barcode labels for tracking.

Modern Library Features:

1. Digital Facilities:

- Introduction of RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) systems to enhance library operations.
- Students are required to scan their ID cards for library access, and books are issued and returned through the library software.

2. Access to Resources:

- Students can explore the available books using an online public access catalog (OPAC) feature integrated into the library software.
- The library is a member of INFLIBNET's N-LIST program, granting access to 6,000 e-journals and 3,000,000 e-books, which can be utilized from any location with internet access.

3. Encouraging Competitive Exam Preparation:

 A wide range of books catering to various competitive examinations is available in a dedicated reference section, aimed at motivating and equipping students.

4. Annual Additions:

o For the academic year 2023–2024, 425 books worth ₹2,00,000 were purchased with government funding to support various departments.

5. Enhancing Research:

 The library facilitates access to Shodhganga, an INFLIBNET repository for research and thesis submissions, to link the works of all faculty members. This initiative is expected to significantly encourage and support faculty research endeavors.

Through these initiatives, the central library of Sri Meenakshi Government Women's Arts College continues to play a pivotal role in enriching the academic and intellectual pursuits of its students and faculty.

1. Free Training for TNPSC Group I-A Exam

Madurai IAS Academy provides free coaching sessions for the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission (TNPSC) Group I-A examination to 15 students, with one student selected from each department of the college. These special classes, which began on September 18, 2023, are conducted every Sunday and are ongoing.

2. Natural Farming Training for Science Students

In collaboration with Mahindra Pride Classroom through the Nandhi Foundation, training on natural farming was conducted for 50 final-year undergraduate science students from the Departments of Zoology, Botany, and Home Science from September 25, 2023, to September 27, 2023.

3. Job Placement through QSpiders

Seven alumni from the college successfully secured job offers after clearing a telephonic interview conducted by QSpiders, a Bengaluru-based company. This included three undergraduate Computer Applications students and four postgraduate Computer Science students.

Mega Job Fair

On October 14, 2023, the college hosted a mega job fair in association with the Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women and the Tamil Nadu Urban and Rural Livelihood Mission. Over 150 companies participated in the event, providing employment opportunities to both current and former students, as well as the general public.

5. "Naan Mudhalvan" Training Initiative

As part of the Tamil Nadu government's "Naan Mudhalvan" employment initiative, a two-day program was organized on November 1, 2023, and November 2, 2023, for second- and third-year undergraduate students. A total of 1,846 students, including 946 second-year and 900 third-year students, participated and benefited from this training.

6. Campus Recruitment Drive by DLO Technologies

A campus recruitment drive was conducted by DLO Technologies Private Limited, a Madurai-based private company, on January 31, 2024. The event saw the participation of 190 final-year undergraduate and postgraduate students, of whom 10 students successfully received job offer letters.

he private company Aurolab, operating in Madurai, conducted an on-campus recruitment ive at our college on February 9, 2024, where 115 final-year undergraduate students articipated. Among them, 73 students successfully secured job offers and were given oppointment letters.

To motivate our college students preparing for the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission (TNPSC) Group I-A exams, a seminar titled "Journey to Success: Insights from TNPSC Group I-A Achievers" was held on February 28, 2024. The event featured speakers such as Ms. Abhinaya Aarthi, Ms. Petchiyammal, and Mr. Mohammed Absar, junior assistants currently working after succeeding in the TNPSC Group I-A exams. They shared strategies and tips for success, benefiting 138 participating students.

In the upcoming days, additional campus recruitment drives are planned to ensure employment opportunities for our students. For example, on March 23, a skill assessment session aimed at enhancing employment opportunities for final-year differently-abled students in private organizations will be conducted in collaboration with the NGO Nesam Charitable Trust.

Throughout this academic year, the Career Guidance and Placement Cell's efforts have significantly contributed to enhancing students' employability and securing suitable job opportunities.

Achievements:

- Ms. I. Zehra, a student from the Economics department, won the first prize in Pencil Sketch and Poster Making competitions at inter-collegiate events held at Fatima College, Madurai.
- 2. Ms. L. Arimeenakshi, a third-year undergraduate student from the Chemistry (English medium) department, qualified for a government position.
- 3. On February 9, 2024, during the Aerolab recruitment drive, 19 students were hired for various positions.
- 4. Four Computer Science students secured jobs as web and software developers at Teal Technologies. Out of 100 students, six were selected as Scout Scholars, a program organized by the British Council and the Naan Mudhalvan initiative.

Alumni Initiatives:

To foster talent recognition and confidence among students, a motivational event was conducted with **R. Sivaranjani**, a second-year postgraduate student in Tamil literature, and **V. Vasuki**, a third-year undergraduate student in Tamil literature who cleared the **Police Constable Exam**. They shared insights under the topic "**Preparing for Exams**", marking a new milestone in the Tamil department's history.

Mudhalvan Initiative Report (2023-2024):

The Naan Mudhalvan Initiative Committee is chaired by Dr. S. Vanathi, with coordination by Dr. R. Sathyabama (Associate Professor, History), and contributions from pr. A. Dhuraikannan (Commerce) and Dr. Chandrasekar (Mathematics).

In the 2023-24 academic year, skill enhancement training was introduced for students in the first, third, and fifth semesters of undergraduate arts and science programs as part of the Naan Mudhalvan curriculum. Representing the initiative, **Dr. J.B.Sharmila**, Head of the Department of Home Science, and **Dr. R. Sathyabama**, Naan Mudhalvan Coordinator, participated in the curriculum alignment meeting held in Chennai on **July 14, 2023**.

During both semesters, Madurai Kamaraj University conducted a three-phase training program for professors under its Quality Improvement Scheme, with approximately 30 professors participating and benefiting.

- 1. Curriculum Enhancement for Students:
 - First-Year Students: A foundational curriculum focused on personal development.

During the academic year 2023-24, the **Consumer Forum**, in collaboration with the Departments of Economics and Commerce, has been functioning successfully. The college principal, **Dr. L. Vanathi**, serves as the Secretary of the Consumer Forum, with **Dr. M. Aruna**, Associate Professor of Economics, as the Coordinator.

The year 2023-24 was declared the International Year of Millets by the Department of Food Supplies and Consumer Protection. Following this, on December 8, 2023, a Millet Food Festival was organized by the Consumer Forum at Madurai Social Sciences College, under the leadership of the District Collector. The event aimed to raise awareness about millets among young consumers. Students from our college participated and showcased their culinary skills by preparing millet-based dishes, earning certificates for their efforts. Prizes and certificates were distributed to the participating students by the Principal of our college.

On January 20, 2024, to mark World Consumer Day, poetry, essay, and painting competitions were conducted at the Madurai District Collectorate. On February 14, 2024, the District Collector, Mrs. M. Sow. Sangeetha, presided over the National and World Consumer Rights Day celebrations and honored the winners with shields and certificates. Notably, S. Mariyammal, a third-year Economics student from our college, won the third prize in an essay competition involving eight colleges.

Grandparents and Students Club (2023-2024)

The Grandparents and Students Club of Sri Meenakshi Government Women's Arts College held a meeting on March 15, 2024, at 10:30 AM in the RUSA Hall. The event commenced with a prayer, and Dr. G. Vijayam, Assistant Professor of the Department of

Postgraduate and Tamil Studies, welcomed the attendees. The Principal, Dr. L. Vanathi, delivered the keynote address, emphasizing the importance of elders in the family.

Fifty third-year Zoology students from our college participated, identifying around 25 butterfly species across the campus.

Alumni Association

The Alumni Association of Sri Meenakshi Government Women's Arts College was formally registered on May 29, 2015, under Section 10 of the Societies Registration Act and has been functioning efficiently. The association operates with a ten-member executive committee, with Dr. S. Vanathi as President, Dr. A. Rajeshwari Pushpam as Secretary, and Dr. A. Sameem Banu as Treasurer.

Annual graduation ceremonies are organized through the Alumni Association, involving undergraduate, postgraduate, and Ph.D. scholars. In the academic year 2023-24, the association hosted a reunion for Geography students from 1983-1988 on August 13, 2023, at the RUSA Hall. Mrs. Y. U. E. Shanthi, an alumna, donated a sound system and stage setup for the department and an air-conditioning unit for the college, enhancing the institution's facilities.

Science Forum

On 28th February 2024, the Science Forum organized a special lecture to celebrate National Science Day. The lecture was delivered by Mrs. N. Bodhumani, Associate Professor of Geography, on the topic "Atmosphere."

To support students' academic growth, the Curriculum Development Committee of the college has successfully introduced updated syllabi. Meetings of subject-specific syllabus committees across departments have also been conducted. Further, all departmental forums, clubs, student empowerment committees, career guidance committees, sports committees, library committees, online committees, and the science forum committees held meetings and received approval in the Academic Council meetings. Additionally, meetings of the Planning and Evaluation Committee, Finance Committee, and Governing Committee have been conducted.

Muthamizh Vizha (Classical Tamil Festival)

The Muthamizh Vizha was held on 20th March 2024 at Sri Meenakshi Government Women's College.
