RESEARCH POLICY

The college has a well-defined policy for research promotion, which is available on the college website.

Research is facilitated at the department level at Sri Meenakshi Government Arts College for Women (Autonomous) through curriculum-based undergraduate research projects, postgraduate projects, PhD projects and internship Initiative. Our institution's Research Committee, which was established in 2017, encourages faculty and student research. The Research Committee is responsible for ensuring the quality of research projects and observance of research ethics. The committee is made up of a five-member Core Group and an extended group that includes the heads of every Research Centre. The committee evaluates research ideas for feasibility, originality, and proper implementation. The college also encourages faculty members' participation in national and international seminars, conference, and workshops. It also aids in the organization of departmental seminars and other research-related activities. Staff and students of our college are encouraged to present their research at national and international conferences and publish their papers. A Project Monitoring Committee has been formed to facilitate the following research processes: releasing funds in time for sanctioned projects, providing seed money, simplifying procedures related to procurement made by investigators, giving autonomy to the principal investigator/ coordinator for utilising overhead charges, timely release of grant, timely auditing and submission of utilisation certificate to the funding authorities. All the processes listed above are in place to ensure that research plans and projects function smoothly. In addition to the ongoing functions, the institute makes every effort to ensure that the teachers and students engaged in research are interactive and collaborative to contribute to the welfare of the institution through meaningful research initiatives. ICT assistance for promoting multi-media access and INFLIBNET are provided to all the departments in order to carry out research work. The centralised amenities include a library with a large selection of physical and electronic journal subscriptions, as well as internet access.
