GANDHIJI STAYED IN THE COLLEGE CAMPUS DURING HIS VISIT TO MADURAI



First Visit (March 26-28 1919)
Gandhi's maiden visit to Madurai was to meditate on the situation in the Punjab. He stayed in the bungalow of his close friend, Dr. George Joseph, at the entrance to the southern bank of the river Vaigai, very close to A.V. Bridge.

Second Visit (September 20-22, 1921)
The second trip visited by Mahatma Gandhi to the town of Madurai, for the first time, was to attend the annual meeting of the Indian National Congress in the town of Madurai. He stayed in the bungalow of his close friend, Dr. George Joseph, at the entrance to the southern bank of the river Vaigai, very close to A.V. Bridge.

Third Visit (September 28-30, 1927)
The third visit was to complete the work of the Indian National Congress in the town of Madurai. He stayed in the bungalow of his close friend, Dr. George Joseph, at the entrance to the southern bank of the river Vaigai, very close to A.V. Bridge.

Fourth Visit (January 25-27, 1931)
Gandhi came to the town of Madurai for the first time in the year 1931, to attend the annual meeting of the Indian National Congress in the town of Madurai. He stayed in the bungalow of his close friend, Dr. George Joseph, at the entrance to the southern bank of the river Vaigai, very close to A.V. Bridge.

Fifth Visit (February 2 and 3, 1946)
The fifth visit was to attend the annual meeting of the Indian National Congress in the town of Madurai. He stayed in the bungalow of his close friend, Dr. George Joseph, at the entrance to the southern bank of the river Vaigai, very close to A.V. Bridge.

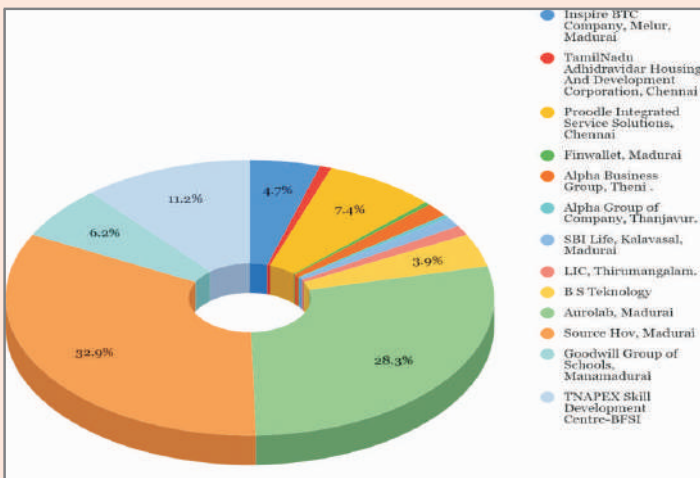

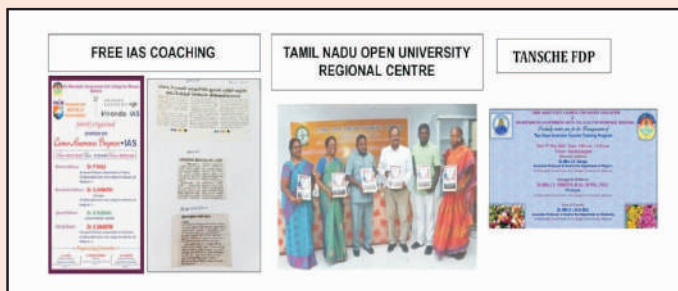

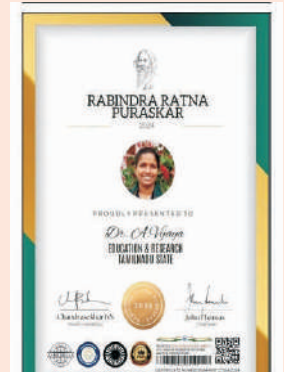
