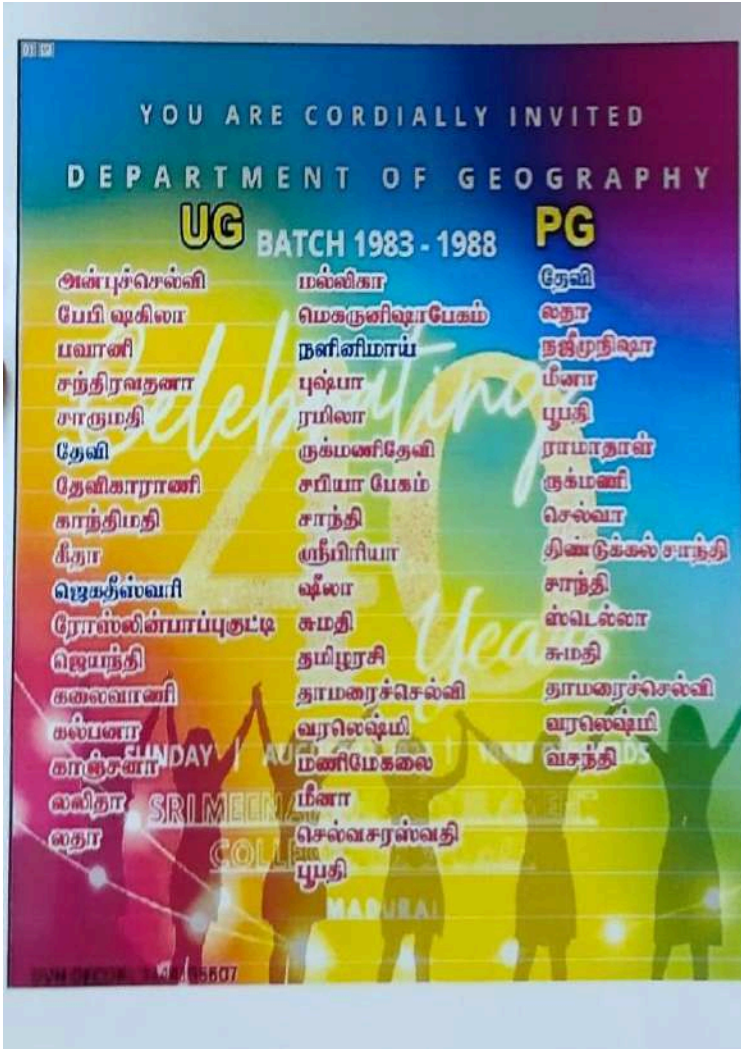

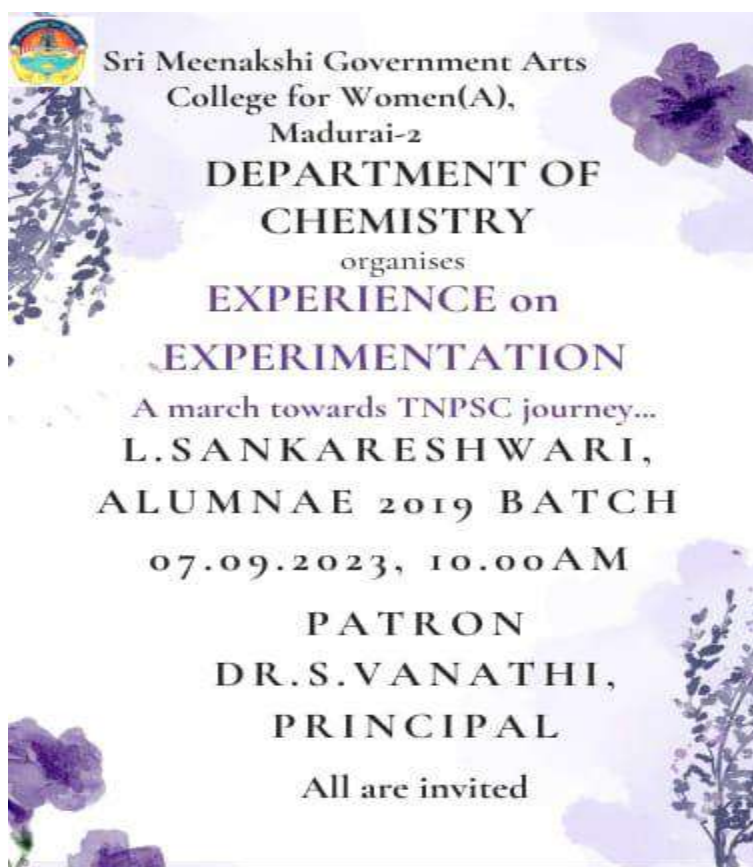

The workshop was titled "A Workshop on Unveiling Opportunities: An Introduction to NET/SET Examinations" and the programme was intended for IMA, II MA, M.A., NET, and III BA English students. The resource person for the workshop was Ms. M. Nasreen, M.A., NET, a Guest Lecturer from the Department of English at Raja Doraisingam Govt. Arts College, Sivagangai. She is an alumna of 2015-2020 batch of PG and Research Department of English. The workshop aimed to provide guidance and support to candidates preparing for the NET exam, which is an essential qualification for lecturership and research fellowship in Indian universities and colleges.

### Objectives:

1. To familiarize participants with the exam pattern and syllabus of the NET exam.
2. To equip participants with effective study techniques and time management strategies.
3. To provide subject-specific content review and practice exercises.
4. To offer tips and strategies for answering multiple-choice questions and essay writing.
5. To conduct mock tests and practice sessions to simulate exam conditions.

### Workshop Content:

The workshop covered various aspects essential for NET preparation, including:

1. Understanding the exam pattern, marking scheme, and syllabus.
