## RESOLUTIONS

1. The Board resolved to Pass The following Ratification for The Naan Mudhalvan course for the Academic Year 2022-2023
  - **Naan Mudhalvan course "Digital Skills for Employability"** for 2 hours – 2credits offered in semester-IV can be accommodated in department workload by changing hours and credits of core course **International Economics (E41)** from 5 hours – 5 credits to 4 hours – 4 credits and skill based Elective course **Marketing(SE42)** from 2 hours – 2 credits to 1 hour – 1 credit.
  - **Naan Mudhalvan course " Digital Banking, Logistics and Audit esseutials"** for 2 **hours** – 2credits offered in semester-VI can be accommodated in department's work load by changing hours and credits of skill based elective courses **Personality Development(SE65)** and **Economics of Tourism and Travel Management(SE66)** from 2 hours – 2 credits to 1 hours – 1 credit.
2. The Board resolved to Pass The following Ratification for The Naan Mudhalvan course for the Academic Year 2023-2024
  - The Skill enhancement course **Introduction to Ms Office (U22SEE1)** with 2 hours & 2 credits in the III – Semester For The Academic Year 2023-24 is replaced by the **Naan Mudhalvan course "Digital Skills for Employability"** with 2 hours & 2 credits.

- The skill based elective course **Business Communication(SE53)** with 2 hours & 2 credits in the V – Semester for the academic year 2023-2024 is replaced by the Naan Mudhalvan course **Management and Market Strategies for Employability** with 2 hours & 2 credits as per the **TANSCHE** recommendation

3. It is resolved that the Generic Elective Course (Allied course) fundamentals of Management / Introduction to sociology in the I- Semester and History of Economic Thought / Introduction to E- commerce in the second semester shall be introduced as self allied paper for First year Economics students in the academic year 2023-2024.

4. It is resolved that ,based on the requirement, the Generic Elective courses (Allied) **General Economics** in III – Semester & **Banking theory, practice and insurance** in the IV-semester to be offered for **B.SC Geography** students those who joined in the academic year 2023-2024 instead of statistics –I in III- Semester and statistics –II in IV - Semester.

5. It is resolved that the student must undergo the **Summer Internship/ Industrial training** for a minimum of 30 hours at the end of the fourth semester as per the TANSCHE syllabus.

6. It is resolved to offer a core course (CC12) “**Environmental Economics**” in the V –semester as per the **TANSCHE** Syllabus
