

7.1.9 Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens (within 500 words).



The National Service Scheme (NSS) and National Cadet Corps (NCC) are two integral bodies that commit to programmes and activities to inculcate constitutional obligations and patriotism among students and staff. The college renders national service by organising road-safety awareness programmes routinely.

Students are informed about traffic rules and regulations and instil the importance of safeguarding human life. To promote a sustainable environment, the ideal of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, SMGACW organises cleanliness drives like SwachhtaPakhwada. The college has also initiated the Swachh Bharat campaigns and Tree Plantation drives are organised. As part of the campaigns, environmentally safe practices such as plastic ban, water conservation, waste segregation, cleanliness and anti-pollution campaigns are organised regularly.

Democratic values : The college enshrines the sovereign and democratic values of our nation by commemorating the "Independence Day" celebrated annually on August 15 by hoisting the national pride tricolour flag at our college premises by the Principal. 



4. The Student Community both in the High school and college level should be utilized by the department of Education to create awareness of the salient features in the Act among public.
 5. The welfare forms under the rule should be simplified and translated and should be available in all offices including Panchayat, Block Development Office, Revenue Division Office, Talisildar Office, Social Welfare Office and Collectorate as required under 20(A) of the rules.
 6. 24 hours helpline should function with free homes tie up to accomodate indigent senior citizens till a government managed old age home is constructed and functional.
 7. The District Administrations shall issue Identification card for abandoned and indigent Senior Citizens after a detailed survey.

The Secretary, Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme Department appreciated the efforts taken by all the concerned departments for the welfare of senior citizens and examined the replies furnished by the departments in respect of the directions of the Court. He also insisted that necessary proposals for future course of action may be sent to Government in respect of some recommendations which are yet to be implemented.

Regarding the establishment of Old Age Home in all districts, the Director of Social Welfare informed that in the state of Tamil Nadu, already 64 Old Age Homes are functioning with Central Government Grant-in-aid and 22 Old Age Homes / 51 Integrated Complexes meant for both children and abandoned elderly persons are functioning with State grant-in-aid, and periodical inspections are carried out by respective District Social Welfare Officers.

Regarding the appointment of Geriatric Specialist in Government Hospitals & introduction of specialized Geriatric Course in Medical Education etc. the official from Medical Department informed that recently Geriatric Care is gaining momentum and inclusion of Geriatric Care Course in Medical Education is under consideration of the Government. The Secretary, Social Welfare Department informed that the reply may accordingly be furnished and these points may be included in the reply to be submitted to Hon'ble High Court of Madras at Madurai.

at the grass root level (like panchayat), through Social Welfare Department and necessary training may also be provided to officials and staff of the Tribunals who handle the cases filed under the MWPSO Act (RDGs of the concerned institutions). A curriculum should be developed through the training institute to give better effect and awareness about the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act 2007 and Rules 2009.

Regarding the helpline for rescue of senior citizens, the Director of Social Welfare informed that helpline number 1253 in Chennai / Tricity districts and other districts helpline number 1800-180-1253 is already functioning in the entire state of TamilNadu. The distressed senior citizens who are in problems can contact this number and get assistance relating to counselling, legal help, admission to old age homes and other aids.

The Secretary of Social Welfare Department instructed to create more awareness of the MWPSO Act through press releases & wide publicity in all districts by District Collectors. He instructed that necessary steps may be taken to publish the MWPSO Act and Rules in the website in both English and Tamil languages and a separate letter may be sent to the law department for translation of the Act, Rules and related Government Orders in Tamil. Awareness programmes may also be conducted through the NSS, NYK, SHG and other groups.

The Secretary also insisted to furnish revised compliance report on the details of measures already implemented / programmes to be implemented and various other proposals under consideration of Government for implementation in future by the concerned departments.

The Secretary instructed to send a letter by the Social Welfare Department to all the concerned departments regarding the stage of the implementation of Welfare of Senior Citizens as per the Court Order and all the departments were requested to send their revised action taken report in detail so that based on their reply a final consolidated report will be sent to Government and a compliance report will be filed in the Hon'ble High Court of Madras at Madurai in W.P.No. 3381 of 2011 and W.P.No.2556 of 2011 filed by Thiru Athiyayathurai, Thiruvorur and Thiru K. Ramprabhu.

The meeting came to an end with vote of thanks by the Director of Social Welfare.






