RESOLUTIONS:

The following are the resolutions made in the meeting:

1. It was decided that the Undergraduate students of 2023-2026 batch shall undergo Summer Training after completing the Semester IV examinations and the Postgraduate students of 2023-2025 batch shall undergo Internship after completing the Semester II examinations for a minimum of 30 hours irrespective of the number of days.
2. It is mandatory to obtain Attendance Certificate from the respective companies/ organizations in which the students undergo training / internship (preferably in the company's letter head). Attendance Certificate format enclosed shall be used by the students.
3. As suggested by the University Nominees of the Academic Council it was decided to follow the evaluation pattern mentioned below for Extension Activities and Internship/ Summer Training:
 - a. Attendance (mandatory) - 40 marks
 - b. Field work and performance - 40 marks
 - c. Report writing - 20 marks
4. Question Pattern for SEC-IV (Entrepreneurial Skill) for 2023-2026 batch shall be as follows:

Part A (Internal choice - either/or)

5 x 5 = 25

Part B (Internal choice - either/ or)

5 x 10 = 50

If the department offers it as a practical paper, then the evaluation pattern will be in accordance with the existing pattern followed for other practical papers.

5. It was decided to follow the TANSICHE syllabus for the forthcoming academic year 2024-2025 adhering to the structure prescribed. BoS to be completed by the departments on or before March 12, 2024.
6. Differently Abled students who prefer to opt for Naan Mudhalvan courses shall be permitted to do the same. If not they can be allowed to opt for the SEC paper offered by the departments in the respective semesters.


